

FILM INVESTOR CHECKLIST

You should have the majority of the following assets before pitching your independent film to a possible film investor.

Your focus should be obtaining development funds from your first possible investor. Development funds should be 5%-10% of your total projected budget. That is enough to cover the initial cost of setting up the film as a business so you can legally start accepting money.
